

The company's workforce consists of 32 employees, ranging between supervisors, drivers, purchasers, cutters and general workers, including the operations of a smaller depot in the industrial area of Swakopmund.

Being registered with the Employment Equity Commission, management is engaged in proactive employment practices to promote employment equality and Scrap Metal Sales is also NEEF compliant.

The company owns a fleet of seven trucks, including 1x link truck, 2x hydraulic skip trucks, 2x trucks with hi ups and 2x smaller trucks that operates between local clients and clients based as far as Okahandja and Otjiwarongo. At the scrap yard the operations are supported by 6x forklifts, 1x excavator, 1x large baler press machine and 1x smaller baler press machine.
